The Landeez ATW is a light weight (37lbs) manual push wheelchair with the capability of carrying a person up to 25 stone. With its balloon type tyres and marine grade stainless steel frame this chair is built to go in the sea on the beach and off roading.

The rear balloon wheel has a wheel lock system to stop the chair from rolling away.
