The purpose of an Emergency Action Plan is to protect the employees from serious injury, property loss, or loss of life, in the event of an actual or potential major disaster. A major disaster may include, but not limited to, any of the following: fire, bomb threat, or hazardous chemical spill.

In the event of a major disaster, an Emergency Action Plan describes the initial responsibilities and actions to be taken to protect all employees until the appropriate emergency services respond.

If your company does not have an emergency action plan; and in the event of an incident and someone gets hurt, you may be liable to civil or legal proceedings.
