Conductor and tutor: **John Butt OBE**

The last workshop in our 2012/13 season is designed to explore the wonderful heritage of German sacred vocal music in the seventeenth century, both that which is in motet style and that which comes closer to the more modern sacred concerto. We will explore several pieces by Heinrich Schütz, including one of the early psalm settings and the Musicalische Exequien; Dietrich Buxtehude's motet Jesu Meine Freude and Das neugeborne Kindelein; and Johann Christoph Bach's Fürchte dich nicht.

**John Butt OBE** is an orchestral and choral conductor, organist, harpsichordist and scholar who has held the Gardiner Chair of Music at the University of Glasgow since 2001, and has led the Dunedin Consort, a professional vocal ensemble centered in Edinburgh, since 2003. In 2003 John Butt received the Dent Medal of the Royal Musical Association; in January 2011 he became the fifth recipient of the Royal Academy of Music/Kohn Foundation's Bach Prize. As a guest conductor, he has appeared with Philharmonia Baroque Orchestra, the Irish Baroque Orchestra, the Orchestra of the Age of Enlightenment and orchestras at the Berkeley Early Music Festival and Göttingen Handel Festival.
