BSH ORANGE-EYED WHITE CHAMPION.

1st, BOB and GCC

CALLAN & RUSSELL'S – INT CH LABRYS WARRIOR PRINCESS

14a (F) 18.

02. 09

Lovely rounded head shape with chubby cheeks, bite just acceptable, shallow chin. Well set ears but a little oversized. Lovely orange eyes of good shape, set and size. Cobby body with limbs and tail to balance. Short, dense, crisp white coat of clean white. Rather worried but handled well.

BSH CHOCOLATE CHAMPION.

HEALY'S – CHAMPION ARDEEVAN CORMAC

15b (M)

Strong, round head with well developed cheeks, very messy dentition, strong chin. Well set ears that are a little oversized. Yellow eyes that are of a good size, set and shape. Strong cobby body with sturdy limbs and tail to balance. Deep chocolate colour that pales a little at the roots. A little long but dense and crisp in texture. Another worried bunny especially out of his pen but he handled well.

BSH BLACK/CHOCOLATE/CINNAMON TORTIE CHAMPION.

EVANS' – INT CH SLIABH NORTHERNLIGHT

Not a colour and pattern I associate with this exhibitor! Rounded head with chubby cheeks, bite seemed level, good chin. Neat well set ears. Yellow eyes of good shape, set and size. Cobby body with limbs and tail to balance. Lovely short, dense, crisp coat showing well mingled rich colours, all paws broken. A rather feisty girl!

BSH COLOURPOINTED (EX CINNAMON/FAWN) CHAMPION

IZYDORCZYK'S – ALEJANDRO REYS DE SELVA

Lovely, strong rounded head with well developed cheeks, level bite, chin recedes a little. Well set ears of reasonable size. Pale blue eyes of good shape, set and size. Strong, cobby body, lovely sturdy limbs and lovely thick tail with rounded tip. Very dense coat that is crisp but a fraction long. Slate blue points that contrast with coat colour, some shading present especially on his spine line and flanks. A lovely friendly boy who really showed himself off.

BSH BLACK SILVER TABBY KITTEN – FEMALE

1ST AND BOB

WREN'S – HOONIKATZ LITTLE DAZZLER

A very worried young lady who needed a lot of cuddles to help her "unfurl" and show herself off. Rounded top of head, cheeks filling out, level bite, good chin. Ears still a little oversized and high in set. Eyes of good shape, set and size with the green colour starting to develop. Compact body with limbs and tail to balance. Coat is short, dense with crisp tones developing. Good contrasts between black markings and pewter ground colour. Fairly symmetrical oysters, good butterfly, clear spine lines, spotty tummy and paws, tail rings evident, two complete necklets.

1ST – BOB AND CC

RASZKA'S – CAIRNCATS RASZKA'S WONDER

06. 05. 10

Just a year old and looking a little immature and rather overawed by events but he handled well. Flat skull, angle still developing, slight bump on his nose, level bite, slightly receding chin. When encouraged shows nice whisker pads. Well set ears but a little small. Pale green eyes of good shape, set and size. Elegant body that needs to fill out and mature with limbs and tail to balance. Mid blue coat that is sound to the roots. Acceptable depth for the time of year except along the spine line, short overall.

KORAT CHAMPION.

1ST – BOB AND GCC

NICHOLL'S – CH NIKELSILVA NEPTUNE

A lovely, quiet, friendly gentleman who was a pleasure to handle. Pleasing muted heart shape to head overall, short nose, level bite, good chin. Well set ears of good size. Good breadth between large, green eyes of good shape, set and size. Semi-cobby body with limbs to balance, tail a fraction short. Fairly close lying coat of mid blue that breaks as he moves and is short and fine in texture.

CORNISH REX – PRE-CHAMPION

1ST – BOB AND CC

LEBIODA'S – SHERIDAN VINSENT

33/40.1 (M)

30. 05. 08

A friendly boy who enjoyed his cuddles. Flat skull to head of overall acceptable length, rounded muzzle, level bite, slightly receding chin. Good cheekbones. Ears of good shape, set and size. Eyes of good shape, set and size. Very elegant neck and body which is lovely and muscular with limbs and tail to balance. Short, fine coat that covers well with even rexing throughout.

SPHYNX INTERMEDIATE - ADULT

1ST – BOB AND IC

LASTAUSRIENE'S - ALNAKEED MOON BEAM

84.14b (F) 24.

07. 10

Even tempered girl who handled and showed well. Flat skull to moderate wedge that shows rounded contours. High cheekbones, slight stop present, whisker break with good whisker pads. Large well set ears of good shape. Lemon shaped eyes of good set but a little small. Lovely long elegant neck and body with long limbs and long slender tail to balance. Reasonably "cushioned" pads. Down covering throughout that shows resistance, slightly heavier on the bridge of nose and tail tip.

2ND

WOOD & CONCHOBHAIR'S – DADDYO STOTTIECAKE

84.31 (F) 09.

05. 10

Love the name! She was a little overawed by events but handled well. Just a year old and still showing a slightly rounded skull to a modified wedge that shows rounded contours, good cheekbones, whisker break but lacks stop, level bite, receding chin. Ears of good shape, set and size. Eyes being held very rounded even when relaxed but large and set well apart. Muscular body of good length, long limbs and slender tail of good length, cushioned pads. Lightly covered in down throughout which has a slight resistance to touch.

SPHYNX INTERMEDIATE – KITTEN

1ST - BOB

LASTAUSRIENE'S – KARASH AMADEUS

07. 09. 10

A huge boy for his age! Slightly rounded skull to modified wedge that shows rounded contours, good cheekbones, nose a little straight, level bite, whisker break, receding chin. Ears of good shape, set and size. Eyes of good size and set but tended to round them when out of the pen. Muscular body of good length with limbs and tail to balance, cushioned pads evident. Covered with down throughout although rather harsh on his flanks, a little heavier on his nose.

CORNISH REX – PRE- PREMIER

1ST BOB AND PC

EARNSHAW & DUNNE'S – LORRENTINO GIVEMESOMELOVE

Rather worried by events but handled well. Flat skull to medium wedge, muzzle a little narrow, level bite, good chin. Well set ears of nice shape and reasonable size. Eyes of good shape, set and size. Long, elegant body with limbs and tail to balance. Coat covers throughout, soft, fine and dense but a little long, very gentle rexing.

DEVON REX GRAND PREMIER

1ST BOB AND GCC

EARNSHAW & DUNNE'S – GR & INT PR LORRENTINO TIGER-LILY

33a 30 (FN) 24.

08. 07

A very feisty girl who lived up to her name and nearly blew her chances with her behaviour which resulted in blood being drawn however I gave her the benefit of the doubt as she was bought to the table in a soft, squishy carrier that was totally unsuitable in a ring-judged show.

That said, she is a girl with overall good type. Flat skull to short, broad wedge, stop present, high set cheekbones, shallow chin. Ears of good size with width to base but a little high in set. Eyes of good shape, set and size. A little heavy in the body but strong and muscular, limbs to balance, tail a little short. Very short, dense coat that covers throughout and rexs gently.

DEVON REX – PRE PREMIER

1ST BOB AND PC

WOOD & CONCHOBHAIR'S – GRIZABELLA FIACHRA
08. 07

33a 30 (MN) 24.

This fella had a grumble in his throat but handled well. Flat skull to a broad, short wedge, high set cheek bones, stop present, very messy dentition, good chin. Large well set ears with width to base. Eyes of good shape, set and size. Strong body that is a little heavy with limbs and tail to balance. Coat covers throughout and is dense and soft but a little over length in places, rexs gently.

SPHYNX INTERMEDIATE – NEUTER

1ST BOB & IC

KIELY'S – DADDYO BLACK PUDDING
09. 05. 10

84 15 (MN)

I hate black pudding but this fella could change my mind! A young man who is still showing a slightly rounded skull to a moderate wedge with rounded contours. Reasonably developed cheekbones, rather a straight profile, slight whisker break, level bite, shallow, receding chin. Ears of good shape and size but a little high in set. Lemon shaped eyes when relaxed, good size and set. Body is a little heavy but muscular with long limbs and tail to balance, nicely "cushioned" pads. Down covered throughout but a little heavier on the bridge of his nose.

RASZKA'S - CAIRNCATS WHITE ROYAL

I loved this boy – he is a fine ambassador for his breed and colour with a temperament to die for, he just purred, drooled and head butted while snuggling into me!

Well grown and mature for his age, flat skull to head, angle still a little indistinct, good short, broad wedge with well developed whisker pads, level bite, slightly receding chin. Ears are well set but rather small. Lovely green eyes of good shape and set but a little small, good Russian expression. Long, elegant body that is strong and muscular with limbs and tail to balance. Fine, dense coat that is a little over length, clear white throughout although still showing very faint signs on his head of his "kitten cap"
