Dear Parents

Firstly I would like to take this opportunity to introduce myself, my name is Steve and I am the newest member of the 13th Bristol leadership team.

Not being a local, my experience in scouting was gained in Shropshire where I was active member of the 1st Newport Beaver, Cub, Scout and Bermuda Venture Scout Group.

Hopefully I can pass some of what I have learnt on to our group but it is surprising how quickly you forget things and 13 years is a long time to be out of the scouting game.

Feel free to introduce yourself on a Thursday night.

Back to the more important things and CLIMBING!!

On Thursday 29th March we are planning to take the scouts climbing, at the Bristol Climbing Centre in St Werburghs, Bristol.

The facilities and staff at the centre are excellent and I feel it would be a fulfilling and fun evening with a lot of confidence to be gained for all those that take part.

The session is 90 minutes long and begins at 7.30pm, all equipment is provided by the climbing centre, and all the scouts need to bring is themselves and a head for heights!

The climbing centre operates a 1:9 ratio (qualified instructor to participant), so your child will always be in safe hands, plus I and the other leaders will be there for moral support.

We advise the scouts to wear loose, comfortable clothing such as t-shirts, sweatshirts, or jogging bottoms. If they have their own climbing shoes feel free to use them, otherwise standard trainers will suffice.

We will be operating a first come first served basis as the climbing centre only has capacity for a group of eighteen. Should the uptake be such that we need to run two sessions then we will look to take another group the following week.

The cost of the session is £6 per scout.

The session begins at 7.30pm so we would need to depart Scout Hut at 7pm prompt.
