	Thornbridge Jaipur 5.9% A citrus dominated IPA its immediate impression is soft and smooth yet builds to a crescendo of massive hoppiness accentuated by honey.		Redemption, Big Chief 5.5% Big hoppy IPA style beer, packed full of Kiwi hops with hints of honey and nectar and plenty of tropical citrus and floral notes.
	Redemption, Pale Ale 3.8% Golden amber colour with floral hops on the nose alongside subtle fruit aromas. Toffee sweetness and fruit flavours balanced by earthy hops. Long, dry and satisfying bitter finish.		Darkstar APA 4.7% The yeast strain used for the brewing of this pale, dry American ale is specially imported from the USA, along with Cascade and Centennial hops, to produce this pale ale.
	Wolf, Straw Dog 4.5% Pale and refreshing, this clear wheat beer is brewed in the German style. Soft German hops added to the brew give a wonderful aroma		City of Cambridge, Hobsons Choice 4.1% A light golden bitter with a pronounced hop aroma, contributing to the refreshing bitter aftertaste.
	Darkstar Espresso Stout 4.2 A black beer brewed with roasted barley malt and challenger hops. Then freshly ground Arabica coffee beans, blended especially for Dark Star, are added to the copper .		Nethergate Umbel Magna 5% The addition of coriander completes the original 1750's recipe and adds to this porter's appeal. Step back in time and taste the spiciness of this deep ruby beer
	Elgood's Black Dog 3.6% A traditional dark mild and CAMRA award winner. Well balanced with a full roast flavour.		Marstons, EPA 3.6% EPA is a pint of cold, hoppy zesty goodness. Brewed to be an easy drinking flavoursome beer. It's a refreshing, lighter blonde ale
	Burton Bridge, Old Expensive 6.5% Amber coloured, smooth & bitter with a barley wine taste.		Buntingford, Hurricane 4.3 Light copper/brown best bitter brewed with fuggle hops for a traditional best bitter taste & feel
	Milton, Saturnalia 5.3% A new brew from a local favourite. Strong hop flavour with a slightly caramel malt background.		Milton, Tiki 3.8% A golden Fruity golden ale, with a pronounced apricot character and a lasting bitter finish. Part of the <u>Antipodean</u> range of beers.
	Oakham Scarlet Macaw 4.4 Tart gooseberry and soft peach on the nose. Gooseberries and fruit to taste, before an intense bitterness that's as sharp as a macaw's screech!		Oakham, Bishops Farewell 4.6% A strong premium beer of structured quality, dominated by elaborate fruity hop notes, with a grainy background and dry finish.

	Jever Pilsner 4.9% Unique in taste. The secret lies in the water, which is still taken from the same well used well over 100 years ago. A classic North German Bitter.		Crocodile Pale lager 5.2% Aromatic hops which partly explain the dry and soft taste with low bitterness. A beer that is very easy to drink any time of year.
	Lindemans Pecheresse 2.5% A golden peach lambic with a sparkling appearance and fruity taste. From Belgium		De Graal Dubbe; 6.5% A brown-red ale with the aroma of cake, raisin and a touch of spice. The body is medium to light.
	St Bernardus Pater 6 This "Paterke" is a chestnut coloured dark beer with a high fermentation (6.7 alcohol content) and a full taste.		De Molen Op & Top 4.5% Clear golden with an off-white head. Aroma is sweet, malty and rather hoppy - grapefruit and pine. Flavor is medium sweet and moderate bitter. Dry and moderate bitter finish.
	Monteiths Celtic Red 4.4% From NZ, A Dry Kilned Beer froths up with a slightly roasted chocolate aroma from special kilning. This develops an invigoratingly dry, thirst-quenching characteristic.		Monteiths Radler 4.4% From NZ A refreshing, fruity, lemon and lime-flavoured lager inspired by a drink first served up in Bavaria in the 1920's
	Carib 5.2% From Trinidad Carib Lager a Premium Caribbean Beer with nice refreshing crisp taste. Light golden colour with a sweet aroma and taste.		Cubanero Fuerte 5.4% Brewed in Cuba, also known as Bucanero. A golden beer, with a vigorous and robust flavour.
	Modelo Especial 4.4% A pilsner type beer created in Mexico, was introduced to the market in 1966.		Leffe Ruby 5% A hard to find version of the familiar leffe brand from Belgium, brewed for France export using red fruits.
	Judas 8.5% Full bodied and warming, malty-hoppy, Blond Speciality beer from Belgium		Einstock Icelandic White Ale 5.2% features the complex flavours of the classic witbier, including orange peel and coriander – all brewed with pure Icelandic water
	De Koninck Winter Beer Winter Koninck is a deep amber-coloured top-fermented Belgium ale with 6.5% Alc. vol. and a full-bodied flavour.		Brooklyn Black Chocolate Stout 10.6% Brewed in New York for the winter season. A luscious deep dark chocolate flavour through a blend of specialty roasted malts.
