Penrith Team organised a comprehensive search around her home, with the assistance of Search Dogs, an RAF helicopter and Team members. She was located after 4 hours by Team members driving the adjacent lanes, and taken to hospital for treatment.

Wasdale requested assistance of dogs and Keswick MRT to locate them. Fortunately, they were able to make their way off while the dogs were en route.

He had fallen a considerable distance, with the likelihood that he had been blown off the ridge. Search Dog handlers in the vicinity helped with the evacuation. FATAL.

Dogs were called to back up the search, but the team decided on an early stand down because police were making further enquiries.  The search recommenced at 0930 on 27th October, to be stood down again within 15 minutes when the subject was discovered by police in Broughton in Furness.

Kendal Team organised search parties of the areas close to the misper's home, whilst dogs searched local woodland. She was <b>FOUND by Search Dogs Comet, Corrie and Kess with their handlers</b> as they were just starting their area, and evacuated to an ambulance.

Keswick organised a search with Team members and its own dogs to cover all exits from the area, and they were found by a Team member close to High Spy summit. They had only three waterproof jackets between them, and two small torches.
<b>35</b>	9th October 0800 <b>KIRKBY STEPHEN</b> Stood down 1430  Restarted 15 October 0800, Stood Down 1500	Search Dogs Dynamite, Flash, Ginny, Kidsty, Mist, Moudy + 2 dogs from SARDA England.	A 40 year old man with a history of depression was reported missing, possibly in a woodland area near Barras.	The Team used dogs to clear the areas nearest to the point where his car was found. Articles of bedding possibly associated with the misper were found by Search Dog Kidsty (Pete Collins).  The search was recommenced the following week and the body of the misper was found by a search team member.
