## **Booking Form**

### **Booking Terms & Conditions**

**General Conditions** 

- 1. The seasonal pitches runs from Jan to Jan
- 2.Touring trailers latest arrival time for both caravan touring holiday homes and pitches is 9.30pm
- 3. Pre bookings please, bookings are to be paid and confirmed before siteing
- 4. All prices are exclusive of V.A.T. at the prevailing rate
- 5. Sorry no single sex groups or unsupervised young groups (under 21 years) we are a family park.

### **Touring Pitch Booking Conditions**

- 6. Minimum booking period of 2 nights: 6 9 April, 4 7 May, 1 5 June, 1 July 31 August
- 7. A non-refundable deposit is required on booking of one nights pitch fee. Balance of all charges either pre payable or on arrival.
- 8. A booking is not valid until a fully completed booking form and appropriate payment has been received and confirmed by the Park.
- 9. Telephone bookings are accepted and a non-refundable deposit is required on booking of one nights basic pitch fee by either credit or debit card. No multiple

bookings (2 or more) will be accepted by telephone.

- 10. A maximum of 3 parties will be accepted as a group booking but only by completed booking forms. Parties of more than three will not be accepted.
- 11. Exact pitches can be requested and, although every effort will be made to reserve these, they cannot be guaranteed.
- 12. Should you wish to extend your stay, then this will be subject to pitch availability and may involve moving pitch.
- 13. Tents are not permitted alongside an awning.14. Any cancellation of a booking, must be made more than 24 hours prior to 1pm on arrival date, otherwise you will be liable for full payment of the booking balance.

#### Park Rules

- 15. Authority for the conduct of the Park is vested in the Manager or their representative. In this connection, entry may be refused to or removal required of any persons, tent or caravan.
- 16. Visitors are required to book in on arrival and check out on final departure.
- 17. Speed Limit Strictly 5mph (8km/h) for cars and bicycles.
- 18. One-Way System The one-way roads system applies to cyclists as well as vehicles, and must be observed at all times. Cycling is not permitted between pitches
- 19. Motorised scooters, skateboards and quad bikes are strictly prohibited on any part of the Park.
- 20. Noise All quiet by 11pm at all other times, noise should be kept to a minimum to avoid disturbance to other Park visitors.
- 21. Parking Fire Regulations stipulate that car should be parked in the car park,
- 22. Barbecues and Fires Barbecues are permitted, except in tent areas, but they must be of proper construction, the base of which must not come in to contact

with the grass or pitch marker. Please ensure that coals are properly extinguished before placing in refuse bins. Open fires, of any nature, are strictly prohibited.

- 23. Dogs are permitted on the Park provided that they are kept on short leads. They must not be allowed to soil the ground within the Park accidents must be cleared
- up immediately. Dogs can be exercised on the extensive walks surrounding the Park- again, accidents must be cleared up immediately. Dogs must be supervised
- at all times on the Park and never left unattended.
- 24. All visitors are asked to keep the toilet / shower facilities as clean and tidy as possible not to leave taps running or put articles likely to cause obstructions into the basins, sinks or toilets.
- 25. The contents of chemical toilets must be emptied only at the disposal points provided.
- 26. Suitable receptacles must be used for the collection of waste water these should not be allowed to over-flow and must be emptied only at the disposal points
- 27. Smoking is not permitted in any of the public buildings. Please dispose of cigarette ends carefully in the receptacles provided.
- 28. Litter must always be placed in the many refuse bins provided around the Park. The irresponsible discard of litter, by any person, adult or child, will not be tolerated.
- 29. The washing of dishes, clothes and pets is not permitted within the toilet / shower facilities. Facilities for those purposes are provided elsewhere on the Park.
- 30. Water Hot water must not be carried from the toilet / shower facilities for any purpose.
- 31. Hose-pipes The use of hose-pipes for washing cars, caravans is strictly prohibited.
- 32. Games Visitors should use the central area provided. Please do not cause a disturbance by playing between pitches. Practise golf is not permitted on any part of the Park.
- 33. Laundry The hanging of clothes on lines outside caravans or tents, or on fences, is not permitted. Washing lines are provided near to the laundry.
- 34. Children Parents are responsible for providing all supervision of their children whilst on the Park and in all buildings, children must not be allowed to play in the toilet/ shower facilities.
- 35. Gazebos are not permitted on the park.
- 36. The Park Warden is there to assist park customers and help maintain a peaceful and safe environment for everyone. Failure to comply with
- a Warden's request, may result in the removal from the Park (in conjunction with the Police, where necessary) of any persons, tent, caravan, motor-home or vehicle.
