
CONTROLLED ENTRY

Methods of controlled entry other than the traditional 'intercom system' to release the door lock include the provision of electronic devices,

- Pin Entry Keypads which permit entry when a four digit code is entered.
- Proximity Systems which work when tokens are presented to the reader.
- Hands free Proximity systems are useful for disabled/wheelchair access.
