GREY BIN

The grey bin is for any household waste which can't be recycled or composted. Wrap food waste in paper and/or plastic bags before placing in the bin and keep the lid shut. Make sure bags are free of air as this takes up space in the bin. Think carefully about what you are throwing away; can it be reused or recycled?
